

WORK-FROM-HOME FUNDRAISING IDEAS

The usual lunches and corporate events might be off the cards while we're all social distancing this year, but that doesn't have to put a stop to your fundraising – you just need to get creative!

Here are some of our favourite ideas for raising money from the comfort of your own home (and getting your loved ones involved too).

PASS ON YOUR PUBLIC TRANSPORT FARE

If you've been working from home for a few weeks, it's probably been a while since you've had to top up your travel card or pay for a ticket to use public transport.

So now that you're saving on your weekly commute, why not donate the equivalent of a weekly fare and ask your friends and colleagues to do the same?

DONATE YOUR DAILY COFFEE

Give up your lattes for a certain period of time and donate the amount you would normally spend to the White Shirt Campaign. You might even encourage other coffee lovers to do the same.

To really up the ante, ask your colleagues (who know how much you need coffee) to sponsor you for every day you can go without it. If you're buying three coffees a day at \$5 a pop, that's \$15 in coffee donations per day or \$75 by the end of the work week – as long as you can make it the whole way!

Feeling particularly determined? You could even ask your boss or colleagues to commit to a big donation if you survive the whole month.

TAKE THE WHITE SHIRT CHALLENGE

If you're stuck at home but still want to get people involved in your fundraiser, recruit your Instagram or Facebook followers for the white shirt challenge.

Here's how it works: put a call-out to your family and friends asking them to set you a challenge – it could be doing 50 push-ups, learning a TikTok dance or drawing a self-portrait – in return for a donation to your fundraising page.

Then, it's over to you. Don your favourite white shirt (or find a clever way to incorporate one in the post) and record a video or photo of you completing the challenge. Once the evidence is posted on your social media channels, it's time for your challenger to pay up!
